From St Andrew's - On St. Bartholomew's Day (24th

August) 1662, following the Restoration of Charles II to the throne, a new version of the Book of Common Prayer came into use in all CofE churches in the land - including our St. Andrew's. It has been in use ever since! We plan to celebrate this 350th anniversary - on the day - with a Choral Evensong at 7.30pm and everyone is welcome. Some churches now use more modern revisions of the Prayer Book but many churches (like ours) are happy to continue to enjoy the beautiful language and appreciate the historic links with former generations of worshippers that the BCP offers us. There will be a Commemorative Leaflet about the Book of Common Prayer available on the day.
